

Policy: JCBA Family Law Section

Bench/Bar Guidelines Review Sub-Committee

(Effective February 2018)

Creation and Purpose

The Family Law Section Bench/Bar Guidelines Review Sub-Committee will meet only as commissioned, at least once every 5 years, as directed by the Family Law Section and with approval of the JCBA Board of Directors, to review and revise the Family Law Guidelines.

Appointment of Sub Committee Members

A Selection Panel will appoint up to 15 members to the Sub-Committee; all family court judges are ex-officio members of the Sub-Committee.

The Selection Panel consists of:

Family Law Section Chair, Vice-Chair and Secretary 3 Judges selected by 10th Judicial District Judiciary 1 member of the JCBA Board of Directors, appointed by the President of the BOD

The Selection Panel will appoint up to 15 lawyers and non-lawyer members, one of which will be appointed Chair of the Sub-Committee.

Adjournment of Sub-Committee

Upon approval of the revised Guidelines by the Family Law Section, the Bench/Bar Guidelines Review Sub-Committee shall be adjourned.
